New Construction Applications for residential and commercial jobs should be submitted by the party who will be responsible for the account as early as possible. Incomplete applications will not be processed. If you need an address for your service location, please call your local City or County Planning & Zoning office. You may bring in your application, fax or mail it.

Customer Requirements:

- Completed application
- Electric panel
- If underground service, trench with conduit and pull string provided by customer and inspected and approved by UniSource
- Electric inspections from City, County, and State agencies (Green Tags in Mohave/Red Tags in Santa Cruz)
 - Kingman: City 928-753-5561, County 928-757-0903, State 602-364-1003
 - Lake Havasu City: City 928-453-4149, County 928-757-0903, State 602-364-1003
 - Nogales: City 520-287-7245, County 520-375-7880, State 602-364-1003

Contact UniSource Engineering:

- When customer is ready for a trench inspection prior to backfilling trench
- When customer is ready for an electric panel inspection after obtaining all electrical inspections (Green or Red Tags)

Free Footage Allowances for Permanent Residence:

- A maximum of 550 feet of single-phase primary distribution line and service line

Additional Cost for Electric Facilities

- Cost to customer will be based on estimated installation cost. Line extension costs vary depending on location, terrain and length of lines.

Permanent Residence:

- Site-built home or a manufactured home at least 400 square feet
- County approved septic and water systems
- If your home does not meet these permanency requirements, there are no free footage allowances, and payment is required in advance for all electric facility construction.
